



ICC-Non Silicon Antifoam 28GP

Application

ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP is an excellent general-purpose de-foaming additive to eliminate and prevent foaming in water-based magnetic particle suspensions, aqueous penetrant developer baths, hydrophilic penetrantremover baths and aqueous cleaning solutions. A few drops of ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP are enough to eliminate foaming in most water-based solutions.

ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP can be sprinkled onto the surfaces of baths to eliminate foaming. It is not intended to remove fine lather which may occur in recirculating baths where there is excessive air intake in the recirculation pump.

ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP can be used in textile and leather industry for processes as:

- FINISHING
- PAPER
- OIL & GAS

Storage and Handling

Over six months. This product should be stored between 5 and 40°C in clean sealed containers. The product should not be allowed to freeze.

Packaging & Shelf Life

ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP is packed in 220 lit galvanized or steel drum.

Shelf life: ICC-Nonsilicone Antifoam 28GP has a shelf life of at least six months in room temperature.

Safety

Inhalation: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Keep warm and at rest. If symptoms persist, obtain medical attention.
